









Resident Coordinator system Special Purpose Trust Fund (SPTF) and core staffing structure





Resident Coordinator system core staffing structure: 2019-2023






SPTF distribution (in million USD)




Country level: Resident Coordinator offices core staffing distribution and vacancy

Created with General Assembly resolution 72/279 on the 2018 reform of the UN development system, the Development Coordination Office (DCO) manages and oversees the Resident Coordinator system and serves as secretariat of the UN Sustainable Development Group.

The objective of the Development Coordination Office is to support the capacity, effectiveness and efficiency of Resident Coordinators and the UN development system as a whole in support of national efforts for sustainable development.

DCO is based in New York, with regional teams in Addis Ababa, Amman, Bangkok, Istanbul and Panama, supporting 130 Resident Coordinators and 132 Resident Coordinators' offices covering 162 countries and territories.
